8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 20, CHAPTER 13,
9 SUBCHAPTER 2 TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL FEE ON THE LICENSURE
10 AND REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES USED TO PROVIDE
11 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL FEE ON THE
16 LICENSURE AND REGISTRATION OF MOTOR
17 VEHICLES USED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY
18 MEDICAL SERVICES."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 13, Subchapter 2 is amended
24 to add the following new section:

25 "20-13-212. Additional Fees.

26 (a) There is imposed an additional annual fee of one hundred dollars
27 (\$100.00) for the inspection and permitting of ambulances. The fee shall be
28 collected in addition to the fee provided in §20-13-211 (5).

29 (b) There is imposed an annual fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)
30 for the issuance or renewal of an operational permit for an ambulance service,
31 advanced life support rescue service, or air ambulance service. The fee
32 required by this subsection shall be in addition to all other requirements for
33 the issuance or renewal of an operational permit.

34 (c) The fees established by this section shall be collected by the
35 department. The department shall deposit the fees with the State Treasurer
36 and shall be credited to the Arkansas Medicaid Program Trust Fund."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
