## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE TO PROVIDE A PARIMUTUEL

9 MIXED DRINK PERMIT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

"AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE TO

13

PROVIDE A PARIMUTUEL MIXED DRINK PERMIT"

14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Subchapter 2 of Chapter 9 of Title 3 of the Arkansas Code is  
18 amended by inserting an additional section at the end thereof to read as  
19 follows:

20

"3-9-238. Pari-mutuel mixed drink permit.

21

(a) (1) There is hereby created a pari-mutuel mixed drink permit which  
22 is to be issued for any restaurant, as defined by A.C.A. § 3-9-202(8)(A), in  
23 any county where pari-mutuel wagering has been authorized by law.

24

(2) Such permits may only be issued in cities of the first class  
25 in which the sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized by law.

26

(b) The permit fees and qualifications for such permits are the same as  
27 those currently provided for restaurants as set out in A.C.A. § 3-9-202(8)(A).  
28 *However the seating capacity of such restaurants must be at least two hundred*  
29 *(200) seats."*

30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
3 act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.
