# A Bill

**ACT 1352 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 2051**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 1-4-106 TO CHANGE THE STATE  
9 NICKNAME TO THE NATURAL STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

12 "TO CHANGE THE STATE NICKNAME TO THE  
13 NATURAL STATE."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-4-106 is amended to read as follows:

18 "1-4-106. State nickname.

19 Because of our unsurpassed scenery, clear lakes, free flowing streams,  
20 magnificent rivers, meandering bayous, delta bottomlands, forested mountains,  
21 and abundant fish and wildlife, the official nickname for the State of  
22 Arkansas is proclaimed to be the The Natural State."

24 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
25 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
26 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
32 act are declared to be severable.

34 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
35 hereby repealed.
