**ACT 1353 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 2128**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE SECTION 9-12-312 TO PROVIDE  
9 THAT LIABILITY FOR ALIMONY SHALL CEASE UPON *JUDICIAL*  
10 *DETERMINATION REQUIRING* THE PARTY RECEIVING ALIMONY TO  
11 *PROVIDE SUPPORT OF ANOTHER ADULT PERSON* UNLESS OTHERWISE  
12 ORDERED BY THE COURT OR AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "TO PROVIDE THAT LIABILITY FOR ALIMONY  
17 SHALL CEASE UPON COHABITATION OF THE  
18 PARTY RECEIVING ALIMONY *TO PROVIDE*  
19 *SUPPORT OF ANOTHER ADULT PERSON* UNLESS  
20 OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE COURT OR AGREED

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas code 9-12-312(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:

26 "(a)(1) When a decree is entered, the court shall make such orders  
27 concerning the alimony of the wife or the husband and care of the children, if  
28 there are any, as are reasonable from the circumstances of the parties and the  
29 nature of the case. Unless otherwise ordered by the court or agreed to by the  
30 parties, the liability for alimony shall automatically cease upon the earlier  
31 of:

32 (A) the date of the remarriage of the person who was awarded the  
33 alimony; or

34 (b) the establishment of a relationship that produces a child or  
35 children and results in a court order directing another person to pay support  
36 to the recipient of alimony, which circumstances shall be considered the
