ACT 176 OF 1995
HOUSE BILL 1361

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE GENERAL ACCOUNTING AND BUDGETARY
9 PROCEDURES LAW BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO REQUIRE THE
10 PROCESSING OF CLAIMS COMMISSION AWARDS INVOLVING STATE
11 EMPLOYEE SALARIES THROUGH THE STATE MECHANIZED PAYROLL
12 SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE GENERAL ACCOUNTING
16 AND BUDGETARY PROCEDURES LAW."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 4, Subchapter 16 is hereby
21 amended by adding a new section as follows:

22 "19-4-1615. (a) In the event a state employee is awarded a claim by the
23 State Claims Commission for wages or salaries for personal services rendered
24 for a state agency, such award shall be processed through the state mechanized
25 payroll system.

26 (b) The award shall be paid from the regular salaries and personal
27 services matching appropriation from which the employee is normally paid."

29 SECTION 2. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
36 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 4. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
7 Eightieth General Assembly meeting in regular session, that a delay in the
8 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could result in the loss of
9 state general revenue. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
10 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its
12 passage and approval.
