ACT 201 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 177

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-12-317 RELATING TO
9 PETITIONS TO CHANGE THE CAUSE OR MANNER OF DEATH AS SHOWN
10 ON DEATH CERTIFICATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "RELATING TO PETITIONS TO CHANGE THE

15 DEATH CERTIFICATES."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-317 is hereby amended by adding the
20 following new subdivision at the end thereof:

21 "(c) When a petition is filed with a court of competent jurisdiction to
22 change the cause or manner of death listed on a death certificate which has
23 been signed by the Chief Medical Examiner or by his designee, the State Crime
24 Laboratory shall be notified of such petition and the Chief Medical Examiner
25 or his designee shall be allowed to hear testimony presented by the petitioner
26 and shall be given an opportunity to present evidence to the court to support
27 the original ruling of the Chief Medical Examiner or assistant who signed the
28 certificate."

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30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
