**ACT 210 OF 1995**  
**SENATE BILL 280**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION - ARKANSAS  
11 REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING  
12 JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
16 - VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION -  
17 ARKANSAS REHABILITATION SERVICES  
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education -  
24 Arkansas Rehabilitation Services - Operations for the 1995-97 biennium, the  
25 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed  
26 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas  
27 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
29 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

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8 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

9 the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education - Arkansas

10 Rehabilitation Services - Operations for the 1995-97 biennium, the following

11 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra

12 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: nineteen

13 (19) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to

14 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or

15 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,

18 to the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education - Arkansas

19 Rehabilitation Services, to be payable from the Department of Education -

20 Rehabilitation Services Paying Account, for personal services and operating

21 expenses of the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education -

22 ~~Arkansas Rehabilitation Services - Operations for the biennial period ending~~

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12 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
13 Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education - Arkansas  
14 Rehabilitation Services, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas  
15 Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical  
16 ~~Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, for operating expenses of the~~  
17 Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education - Arkansas  
18 Rehabilitation Services - Cash for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997,

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32 SECTION 5. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL EDUCATION  
33 DIVISION - REHABILITATION SERVICES. Any savings made in State or Federal  
34 appropriations for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Social Security and  
35 Retirement Matching or Maintenance and General Operation, and Grants for

1 Approved Projects may, after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative  
2 Council and upon approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, be  
3 transferred to the "Contractual Services" line item for disabled and in the  
4 establishment, operation and maintenance of facilities, centers or workshops.

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7 SECTION 6. The appropriation and general revenue funds authorized in  
8 Section 3 of this Act for "HOT SPRINGS REHAB *FEDERAL MATCH*" shall be used  
9 exclusively for and by the Hot Springs Rehabilitation Center for the purpose  
10 of providing monies to match any *federal* funds that may become available.

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12 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
18 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
19 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21

22 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
24 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
25 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
32 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
33 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

1 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
2 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
3 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
4 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
10 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
11 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
12 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of  
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the  
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
