ACT 219 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 334

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE PETIT JEAN TECHNICAL COLLEGE
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE PETIT JEAN TECHNICAL
15 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97
16 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Petit
21 Jean Technical College for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number
22 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
23 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
24 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
25 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
26 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
27 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
28 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
29 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Petit
 17 Jean Technical College for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number
 18 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
 19 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: forty-seven (47) temporary or
 20 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided
 21 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this
 22 act for the appropriate classification.

24 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Petit
 25 Jean Technical College, to be payable from the Petit Jean Technical College
 26 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Petit Jean Technical
 27 College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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9 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
 10 to the Petit Jean Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined
 11 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Petit Jean Technical College, for personal
 12 services and operating expenses of the Petit Jean Technical College for the
 13 biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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32 SECTION 5. PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Petit Jean Technical
 33 College shall be to provide a well-qualified workforce through quality
 34 educational programs of occupational and technical education.

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1 SECTION 6. The appropriation level provided in Section 3 of this Act
2 shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas General Assembly to
3 provide a particular level of support from the Work Force 2000 Development
4 Fund for the Petit Jean Technical College but rather that the funds to be made
5 available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and accreditation
6 requirements as determined by the State Board of Higher Education for all
7 technical colleges.

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9 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions
15 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
16 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
17 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
18 disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
10 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
14 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
