10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK AND

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby
21 established for the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission - General
22 Operations for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular
23 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
25 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

1 SECTION 20. RESTRICTION. The Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo
2 Gnat Control Program in Item (05) of Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended
3 only for the control of buffalo gnats in the Arkansas counties of Miller,
4 LaFayette, Little River and parts of Hempstead.

5

6 SECTION 21. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation
7 provided in Section 6 of this Act, which remains at the close of the fiscal
8 year ending June 30, 1996, shall be carried forward and made available for the
9 same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.

10

11 SECTION 22. The Executive Director shall promulgate such rules and
12 regulations as may be necessary for the administration and distribution of the
13 appropriations authorized by Section 19 herein.

14

15 SECTION 23. Any employee of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry
16 Commission serving in the capacity of Livestock Inspector, EIA Inspector, or
17 any position as delegated by the State Veterinarian may also assume the
18 responsibilities and perform in the capacity of a Livestock and Poultry
19 Compliance Officer or NPIP Inspector.

20

21 SECTION 24. There is hereby created on the books of the Treasurer of
22 State, Auditor of State and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special
23 revenue fund to be known as the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund.
24 All fees as classified under the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated 19-6-
25 301 (33) and (34), and all fees as collected under the provisions of Arkansas
26 Code Annotated 2-33-115, and as collected by the Livestock and Poultry
27 Commission shall be deposited in this fund.

28 The Executive Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission, with the
29 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, shall have the authority to
30 transfer funds from the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund to the
31 Livestock and Poultry Fund Account.

32

33 SECTION 25. Arkansas Code Annotated 2-33-111(b)(2)(A) is hereby amended
34 to read as follows:

35 "The fees collected shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special

1 revenues and shall be credited to the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue
2 Fund."

3

4 SECTION 26. Arkansas Code Annotated 2-33-112(b)(2) is hereby amended to
5 read as follows:

6 "The fees collected shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special
7 revenues and shall be credited to the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue
8 Fund."

9

10 SECTION 27. Arkansas Code Annotated 2-33-115 (a)(3) is hereby amended
11 to read as follows:

12 "(3) On each state, district, and county fair held in the State of
13 Arkansas there shall be levied a four and one half percent (4 1/2%) surcharge
14 on each paid admission to the fairs, and such levy shall be remitted to the
15 Treasurer of State, who shall deposit the revenues in the State Treasury to
16 the credit of the Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund."

17

18 SECTION 28. *Funds appropriated in Item (05) of Section 19 of this act*
19 *shall be used to reimburse members of high school 4H clubs, high school FFA*
20 *clubs and Miss Arkansas Rodeo for expenses incurred while representing the*
21 *State of Arkansas at national conferences and events outside the State. The*
22 *State 4H Association and the State FFA Association shall receive funds*
23 *appropriated for expense reimbursement of student members but shall be limited*
24 *to \$10,000 each, or so much thereof that is available. Reimbursement of*
25 *expenses for Miss Arkansas Rodeo shall be limited to \$350 per year.*

26

27 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
33 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
34 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1

2 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
3 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
4 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
5 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
6 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10

11 SECTION 31. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
12 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
13 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

14

15 SECTION 32. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
16 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
17 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
18 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
19 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

20

21 SECTION 33. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
22 with this Act are hereby repealed.

23

24 SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
25 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
26 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
27 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
