# A Bill

**ACT 249 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 1429**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND  
11 IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1312 OF  
12 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
16 - GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION  
17 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

18  
19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP - MATH AND SCIENCE SCHOOL. There is hereby  
22 authorized, for the Department of Education - General Education Division -  
23 Math and Science School, the following maximum number of part-time or  
24 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
25 appropriated to the Department of Education - General Education Division for  
26 such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at  
27 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
28 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
29 classification, which such positions shall be supplemental and in addition to  
30 those positions authorized in Act 1312 of 1993.

31  
32 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - MATH AND SCIENCE SCHOOL. There is hereby  
33 appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to  
34 be payable from the Public School Fund, for personal services and operating  
35 expenses of the Department of Education - General Education Division - Math  
36 and Science School which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds

15 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 18 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
 21 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
 22 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 27 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
 28 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
4 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
5 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
6 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
7 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
10 with this Act are hereby repealed.

11

12 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
13 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the  
14 operations of the Department of Education - General Education Division are,  
15 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Education  
16 - General Education Division to continue to provide essential governmental  
17 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies  
18 for the Department of Education - General Education Division to continue such  
19 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work  
20 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
21 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
22 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
23 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
24 date of its passage and approval.
