Arkansas Code § 19-5-1030 is amended to read as follows: 18 "§ 19-5-1030. Mining Reclamation Fund. 19 20 (a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, 21 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as 22 the Mining Reclamation Trust Fund. (b) This fund shall consist of all forfeitures collected under § 23 24 15-58-101 et seq. and interest earned on the fund, there to be used only to 25 accomplish reclamation of land covered by forfeitures of performance bonds for 26 surface coal mining." 27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 2.8 29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 36 act are declared to be severable.

2	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
3	hereby repealed.
4	
5	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
6	Assembly that accrual of earned interest to the Mining Reclamation Trust Fund
7	is essential for the operation of the Reclamation Program. Therefore, an
8	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
9	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
10	force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
