HOUSE BILL 1526

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
12 BY ACT 931 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
16 AND ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES
17 DIVISION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
22 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, the
23 following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and
24 in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 931 of 1993 and
25 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
26 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
27 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
28 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
29 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
30 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
31 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
32 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
7 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be
8 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and
9 operating expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue
10 Services Division which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
11 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 931 of 1993, the following:

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26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - DATA PROCESSING. There is hereby
27 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue
28 Services, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the purchase
29 of data processing by the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue
30 Services Division which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
31 appropriated in Section 7 of Act 931 of 1993, the following:

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SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - POSTAGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for postage expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 8 of Act 931 of 1993, the following:

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
