# A Bill

**ACT 321 OF 1995**  
**SENATE BILL 343**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOR  
10 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL  
15 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97  
16 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
21 Gateway Technical College for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum  
22 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
23 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
24 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
25 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
26 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
27 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
30 successor.

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18 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Gateway  
 19 Technical College for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of  
 20 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
 21 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty-six (26) temporary or  
 22 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided  
 23 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this  
 24 act for the appropriate classification.

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26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Gateway  
 27 Technical College, to be payable from the Gateway Technical College Fund, for  
 28 personal services and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical College for  
 29 the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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14 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 15 to the Gateway Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
 16 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Gateway Technical College, for personal services  
 17 and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical College for the biennial  
 18 period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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1           SECTION 5. PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Gateway Technical  
2 College is to provide quality technical training programs, transfer programs,  
3 and industrial training in the workplace.

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5           SECTION 6. The appropriation level provided in Section 3 of this Act  
6 shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas General Assembly to  
7 provide a particular level of support from the Work Force 2000 Development  
8 Fund for the Gateway Technical College but rather that the funds to be made  
9 available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and accreditation  
10 requirements as determined by the State Board of Higher Education for all  
11 technical colleges.

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13           SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
14 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
16 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
19 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
20 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
21 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
22 disbursement of said funds.

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24           SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
26 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
27 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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33           SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
34 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
35 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
