10 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE COMMITTEE ON AMENDMENT 73
11 IMPLEMENTATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMITTEE TO UTILIZE

17 "TO CREATE THE COMMITTEE ON AMENDMENT 73
18 IMPLEMENTATION."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. There is hereby created the "Committee on Amendment 73
23 Implementation" to be composed of up to twelve members of the House of
24 Representatives. The members of the House of Representatives shall be
25 selected by the Speaker of the House, at least two of which are serving their
26 first term and at least two of which are serving their second term. The
27 members of the committee shall elect a chairman.

28 The members of the committee shall be entitled to per diem and mileage
29 at the same rates as are provided for the members of the joint interim
30 committees and such per diem and mileage shall be paid from funds appropriated
31 for paying per diem and mileage of members of the joint interim committees.
32 The committee is eligible to receive funds for consultant services and other
33 expenses from the Joint Interim Committee Study Expense appropriation under
34 the same restrictions and procedures as joint interim committees. Staff
35 assistance to the committee is to be provided by the Bureau of Legislative
36 Research as approved by the Executive Committee of the Arkansas Legislative
