ACT 412 OF 1995
HOUSE BILL 1218

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE BANK DEPARTMENT FOR THE
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE BANK DEPARTMENT
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
20 Bank Department for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of
21 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
23 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
24 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
25 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
26 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
27 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
28 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

23 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State
24 Bank Department for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of
25 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
26 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-time
27 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
28 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for
29 the appropriate classification.

31 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State
32 Bank Department, to be payable from the Bank Department Fund, for personal
33 services and operating expenses of the State Bank Department for the biennial
34 period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

SECTION 4. SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to the highly competitive job market conditions for banking industry professionals and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the State Bank Department is authorized special rates of pay for current and new employees up to the levels listed under subsection (a), with additional authority and restrictions as indicated in subsections (b) and (c) below:

(a) Special rates may be authorized for the following classifications only, as indicated herein.

6 (b) Applications for special rates of pay indicated in subsection (a)
7 shall have been reviewed and approved by the Office of Personnel Management
8 after prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

9 (c) This special provision shall be in full force and effect for the
10 biennium beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1997.

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12 SECTION 5. (a) Due to the necessity of recruiting and retaining
13 qualified personnel, the following titles are available to the State Bank
14 Department for the employment of bank examiners:

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22 (b) As bank examiner personnel qualify for promotion according to
23 criteria established by the State Bank Department, the State Personnel
24 Administrator may approve position reclassifications to a higher level
25 classification employing the titles listed in subsection (a) of this section.

26 (c) The State Bank Department shall be limited to a maximum of twenty-six
27 (26) filled positions in utilizing the title of Bank Senior Examiner/Grade 23
28 and fourteen (14) filled positions in utilizing the title of Financial
29 Examiner II/Grade 20. At no time during the 1995-97 Biennium shall the
30 combined use of both titles referenced in this subsection exceed forty (40)
31 total.

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33 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
34 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
4 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
5 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
11 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
18 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
19 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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21 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
22 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
23 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
24 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
25 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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27 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
28 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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30 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
31 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
32 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
33 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
