21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. The Arkansas Legislative Council shall request the
24 appropriate joint interim committee to conduct a study to determine if the
25 transfer authority granted to the Department of Human Services by Arkansas
26 Code 25-10-112 is essential to the efficient and effective operation of the
27 agency.

29 SECTION 2. The joint interim committee shall report its findings and
30 recommendations including any proposed legislation to the Arkansas Legislative
31 Council during the biennial budget hearings held prior to the convening of the
32 Eighty-First General Assembly.

33
34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
