ACT 463 OF 1995
HOUSE BILL 1481

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-609 TO REQUIRE THE
9 POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE AN
10 ANNUAL REPORT ON GRANTS MADE FROM THE SOLID WASTE
11 MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE POLLUTION CONTROL
16 AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE AN
17 ANNUAL REPORT ON GRANTS MADE FROM THE
18 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING
19 FUND."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-609 is amended to add the following new
24 subsection:

25 "*(d) (1) The Department shall prepare an annual progress report on grant*
26 *assistance made under this section. The report shall include the amount of*
27 *each grant, the purpose of the grant, how grant funds were expended by the*
28 *applicant, the results produced or the progress made on the project, and*
29 *revenues produced and tonnages of materials collected by the project.*

30 "*(2) The report for each calendar year shall be filed by the first day*
31 *of July of the following year with the office of the Governor. The report*
32 *shall include information on grant recipients for a period of five (5) years*
33 *from the date of disbursement of funds by the Department.*

34 "*(3) Regional Solid Waste Management Boards shall provide the Department*
35 *with a report summarizing progress in the project, expenditures from the grant*
36 *award, tonnages of materials collected by the project and revenues produced by*

1 the sale of materials collected. The report shall be filed six (6) months
2 after disbursement of funds and semi-annually for each year thereafter.
3 Failure by a Board to file the required reports shall provide grounds for the
4 Department to withhold disbursement of grant funds for subsequent grant
5 rounds."

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7 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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11 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
15 act are declared to be severable.

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17 SECTION 4. The provisions of this act shall be in addition and
18 supplemental to all other laws of the state of Arkansas now in effect and
19 shall repeal only such laws or parts of laws as may be specifically in
20 conflict with this act.
