ACT 488 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 425

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
STATE POLICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
STATE POLICE REAPPROPRIATION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the Department of Arkansas State Police, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 752 of 1993, for construction, acquisition, renovation, equipment purchases, equipment lease and rental, maintenance and/or repairs, in a sum not to exceed \$2,951,625.

(B) Effective July 1, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 1 of Act 4 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 79th General Assembly for the purchase, lease, or issuance of bonds for the purchase or lease of hardware or software and training for an automated fingerprint identification system for the Arkansas State Police, in a sum not to exceed \$6,200,000.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the State Police Equipment Fund, for the Department of Arkansas State Police, the following:

1 (A) Effective July 1, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided in
2 Section 6 of Act 766 of 1993, for acquisition of an automated fingerprint
3 identification system, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000,000.
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5 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to
6 the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the federal funds
7 as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
8 Arkansas State Police, the following:

9 (A) Effective July 1, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided in
10 Item (01) of Section 1 of Act 124 of 1993, for the construction of Highway
11 Patrol Troop J Headquarters, in a sum not to exceed\$17,338.

13 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
14 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
15 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
16 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
17 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
18 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
19 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
20 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
21 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
22 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
23 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
24 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

25 (B) Any restrictions contained in the Acts enumerated in the
26 reappropriation sections of this Act, the restrictions of any applicable
27 provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
28 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal
29 control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of
30 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
31 with in disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically
32 provided otherwise by law.
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34 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
19 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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21 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
22 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
23 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
24 previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects
25 provided or enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire
26 before the adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such
27 appropriations expire, the projects and programs authorized herein will cease
28 thereby depriving the citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from
29 such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this
30 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
31 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
32 passage and approval.
