ACT 493 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 533

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE WHICH SHALL
10 BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1068 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
15 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - CENTRAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby
20 established for the Secretary of State - Central Operations, the following
21 maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and in
22 addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 1068 of 1993 and
23 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
25 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - CENTRAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby

5 authorized, for the Secretary of State - Central Operations, the following

6 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra

7 Help", payable from funds appropriated to the Secretary of State, for such

8 purposes: fourteen (14) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at

9 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and

10 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate

11 classification, which such positions shall be supplemental and in addition to

12 those positions authorized in Section 2 of Act 1068 of 1993.

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14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CENTRAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby

15 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central

16 Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Secretary

17 of State - Central Operations which shall be supplemental and in addition to

18 those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1068 of 1993, the following:

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33 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

34 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
4 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
5 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
11 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
18 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
19 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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21 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
22 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
23 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
24 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
25 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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27 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
28 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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30 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
31 Eightieth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Ninth General
32 Assembly for the operations of the Secretary of State are, due to unforeseen
33 circumstances, insufficient for the Secretary of State to continue to provide
34 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
35 the necessary monies for the Secretary of State to continue such services; and

1 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm
2 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
3 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
4 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
6 approval.
