For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO ADJUST THE SALARIES AND TO MAKE AN
9 APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES WHICH SHALL BE
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
11 BY ACT 3 OF 1995 FOR THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF
12 GOVERNMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH AMENDMENT 70 OF THE ARKANSAS
13 CONSTITUTION."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT TO ADJUST THE SALARIES AND TO

18 DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. The salaries of the following elected officials shall be as
23 follows:

35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to be payable
36 from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for salaries of the various

1 Constitutional Officers which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
2 funds appropriated in Items (1) through (7) of Section 1 of Act 3 of 1995, for
3 the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

9 SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
14 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
15 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
16 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
17 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

18
19 SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
20 this Act are hereby repealed.

21
22 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23 Eightieth General Assembly, that Amendment 70 of the Constitution of Arkansas
24 provides that salaries of the Executive Department officials may be increased
25 annually by an amount not to exceed the average percentage increase in the
26 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers or its successor, as published by
27 the United States Department of Labor, for the two years immediately preceding
28 the year of the salary appropriation; that this act establishes the proper
29 salaries for the Executive Department; that the delay in the effective date of
30 this act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
31 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
32 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
33 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
34 effect from and after July 1, 1995.
