11 PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

20 TEMPORE OF THE SENATE."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-301 (a) is amended to read as follows:

26 "(a) An ad interim committee of the General Assembly is hereby
27 established as a Legislative Council, which shall consist of thirty-six (36)
28 members to be selected as follows:

29 (1) The Senate of the General Assembly shall select sometime
30 before adjournment of each regular session twelve (12) members, with three (3)
31 members to be chosen from each of the four (4) congressional districts of the
32 state in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus of the members of the Senate
33 residing in their respective congressional districts;

34 (2) The House of Representatives of the General Assembly shall
35 select twenty (20) members in accordance with the procedure prescribed by
36 House Rules;
