10 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY
15 DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97
16 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
21 for the State Military Department - Operations for the 1995-97 biennium, the
22 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed
23 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas
24 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
25 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
26 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
30 successor.

 18 SECTION 17. Juvenile participants in the Arkansas National Guard Youth
 19 Challenge Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the
 20 Arkansas National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to
 21 exceed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other
 22 personal necessities, and a monetary stipend not to exceed two thousand two
 23 hundred dollars (\$2,200) upon graduation from the program to defray costs for
 24 additional job training or education. Juvenile participants are authorized to
 25 receive uniforms and clothing items as determined by the staff to be
 26 appropriate for effective participation in outdoor activities.

27
 28 SECTION 18. Juvenile participants in the Civilian Student Training
 29 Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the Arkansas
 30 National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to exceed ten
 31 ~~dollars (\$10.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other personal~~
 32 necessities. Juvenile participants are authorized to receive uniforms and
 33 clothing items as determined by the staff to be appropriate for effective
 34 participation in outdoor activities.

1 SECTION 19. Transportation to support Civilian Student Training program
2 activities for juvenile participants and staff may be provided by commercial
3 lease/purchase of motor vehicles not to exceed six vehicles.

5 SECTION 20. Transportation to support Arkansas National Guard Youth
6 Challenge Program activities for juvenile participants and staff may be
7 provided by commercial lease/purchase of motor vehicles not to exceed six
8 vehicles.

10 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19

20 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28

29 SECTION 23. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
30 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
31 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 24. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 25. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

6

7 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
10 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
14 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
