For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT AMENDING ARK. CODE § 8-9-502 TO AUTHORIZE THE
9 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF POLLUTION CONTROL AND
10 ECOLOGY TO APPOINT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE ARKANSAS
11 NEWSPAPER RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPT.
16 OF PC & E TO APPOINT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS
17 TO THE ARKANSAS NEWSPAPER RECYCLING
18 ADVISORY COMMITTEE."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 8-9-502 is hereby amended to read
23 as follows:

24 "8-9-502. Members.

25 The Director of the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology shall
26 appoint an Arkansas Newspaper Recycling Advisory Committee consisting of:

27 (1) The Chief of the Marketing Division of the Department of Pollution
28 Control and Ecology, or his designee;

29 (2) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Press Association, or his
30 designee;

31 (3) At least six (6) members representing the Arkansas newspaper
32 industry and newsprint manufacturers doing business in Arkansas; provided,
33 however, that these members shall be selected from a list of names of
34 potential members to be provided by the President of the Board of Directors of
35 the Arkansas Press Association."

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
