SENATE BILL 634

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
12 BY ACT 7 OF 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
16 AND ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING
17 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing, to be payable
23 from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating
24 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing
25 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in
26 Section 3 of Act 7 of 1995, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the
27 following:

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5 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - HORSE RACING. There is hereby authorized, for
 6 the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing - Horse
 7 Racing, for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or
 8 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra-Help", which shall be supplemental
 9 and in addition to those authorized in Section 4 of Act 7 of 1995, payable
 10 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes, such employees shall be
 11 authorized to work over 1,000 hours per year.

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16 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 22 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
 23 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
 29 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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10 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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13 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
14 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the
15 operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of
16 Racing are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department
17 of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing to continue to provide
18 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
19 the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
20 Division of Racing to continue such services; and that a delay in the
21 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
22 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
23 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
24 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
25 force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
