ACT 717 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 604

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING SEWER
9 SERVICE MAY REQUEST AN ASSOCIATION OR IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
10 PROVIDING THE WATER SERVICE TO TERMINATE WATER SERVICE TO
11 A CUSTOMER WHO IS DELINQUENT IN MAKING SEWER PAYMENTS; AND
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO ALLOW WATER ASSOCIATIONS OR
16 IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS TO TERMINATE WATER
17 SERVICE TO ANY PERSON WHO OWES A
18 MUNICIPALITY FOR SEWER SERVICE."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. (a) Any municipality owning or operating a public sewer
23 system or sewer improvement district providing sewer service to its citizens
24 may request a water association or water improvement district providing the
25 water service to terminate the water service to any resident who is delinquent
26 at least thirty (30) days in making payment to the municipality for sewer
27 service.

28 (b) The water association or water improvement district shall terminate
29 the water service upon certification by the municipality that the person is
30 more than thirty (30) days delinquent in making payments for sewer service and
31 has been sent notice of the termination of the water service by the
32 municipality.

33 (c) The water association or water improvement district shall send
34 notice to any person who is delinquent in making payments for sewer service of
35 the date the water service will be terminated and shall terminate the water
36 service upon that date unless the balance due the municipality for sewer

1 service has been paid.

2

3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6

7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

12

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
