HOUSE BILL 1408

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-27-104 PERTAINING TO
9 ENGINEERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

12 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-27-104
13 PERTAINING TO ENGINEERS."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-27-104 is amended to read as follows: "§*
18 *17-27-104. Construction.*

19 *The provisions of this chapter affirm the legal authority of an engineer*
20 *licensed under its provisions to provide consultation, investigation,*
21 *evaluation, planning, and design of buildings intended for accommodation of*
22 *equipment, vehicles, goods, and/or processes or other utilitarian functions,*
23 *with human occupancy including office space as required for the support of*
24 *these functions, provided the engineer is practicing within his or her area of*
25 *competency as defined by this chapter."*

27 *SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*
28 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*
29 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

31 *SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to*
32 *any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect*
33 *other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without*
34 *the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this*
35 *act are declared to be severable.*

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.

3 SECTION 5. *It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly*
4 *that it is necessary to clarify the authority of engineers licensed under the*
5 *engineering licensing law; that this act accomplishes the same; and that such*
6 *clarification should be accomplished as soon as possible. Therefore, an*
7 *emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the*
8 *immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full*
9 *force and effect from and after its passage and approval.*
