For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-101 (c) TO REQUIRE THE
9 COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO FILE COPIES OF
10 CHANGES IN ELECTION PRECINCT BOUNDARIES WITH THE SECRETARY
11 OF STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE COUNTY BOARD OF
16 ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO FILE COPIES OF
17 CHANGES IN ELECTION PRECINCT BOUNDARIES
18 WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-101 (c) is amended to read as follows:

24 "(c) (1) The action of the commissioners in changing the voting place in
25 any precinct, in altering the boundaries of any precinct, or in establishing
26 any new one, shall be entered in the record to be kept by them. A copy of the
27 order, which shall set out intelligently and accurately the boundaries of
28 precincts as so altered or established, shall be filed with the clerk of the
29 county court who shall record the order at full length on the record book on
30 which the minutes of the proceedings of the county court are recorded.

31 (2) Within thirty (30) days after altering the boundaries of an
32 election precinct or establishing a new one, the county board of election
33 commissioners shall submit four (4) copies of the changes to the Secretary of
34 State. The changes shall be submitted in the form of a map and shall include
35 a written description. A short statement of why the changes were made may be
36 included. Upon receipt of the changes, the Secretary of State shall

1 immediately forward a copy to the office of the Attorney General, State Data
2 Center, and the Cartography Section of the State Highway Department."

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4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
