# A Bill

**ACT 932 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 1814**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL SELLERS OF GRAVE MARKERS OR GRAVE  
9 HEADSTONES TO ADVISE EACH PURCHASER OF A GRAVE MARKER OR  
10 HEADSTONE THAT IF THE DECEASED IS A VETERAN OF THE ARMED  
11 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, THE PURCHASER MAY REQUEST  
12 THAT THE MARKER OR HEADSTONE SO INDICATE; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES."

16 "REQUIRE SELLERS OF GRAVE MARKERS OR  
17 HEADSTONES TO ADVISE PURCHASER THAT  
18 REQUEST CAN BE MADE TO INDICATE ON  
19 HEADSTONE THAT DECEASED IS VETERAN OF  
20 THE ARMED FORCES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23  
24 SECTION 1. When any person purchases a grave marker or grave headstone  
25 from any seller in this State, the seller shall advise the purchaser that if  
26 the deceased is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, the  
27 purchaser may request that the word "VET" be inscribed in the upper left  
28 corner of the marker or stone.

29  
30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33  
34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
