For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-33-306 (b) CONCERNING
9 THE EXPERIENCE REQUIRED FOR A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE
10 BUSINESS OF AN INVESTIGATION COMPANY; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPERIENCE
16 REQUIRED FOR A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE
17 BUSINESS OF AN INVESTIGATION COMPANY."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-33-306 (b) is amended to read as follows:

23 "(b) (1) An applicant who applies for a license to engage in the
24 business of an investigations company or his manager shall have:

25 (A) two (2) consecutive years' experience prior to the date
26 of the application in the investigative field as an agent, employee, manager,
27 or owner of an investigations company; or

28 (B) been licensed under Acts 1965, No. 447 [repealed]; or

29 (C) two (2) years experience as a licensed bail bondsman
30 and baccalaureate degree from a four-year institution of higher education; or

31 (D) satisfy such other requirements as may be set by the
32 board.

33 (2) The experience of the applicant must be reviewed by the board
34 and determined to be adequate to qualify the applicant to engage in the
35 business of an investigations company."
