For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR LOANS AND/OR
9 SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE RURAL MEDICAL PRACTICE STUDENT LOAN
10 AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND THE COMMUNITY MATCH STUDENT
11 LOAN AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM; ALL AS MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY
12 LAW, FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES
13 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR
14 OTHER PURPOSES."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
24 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be payable from the State
25 General Services Fund Account, for loans and/or scholarships of the Rural
26 Medical Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Program and the Community Match
27 Student Loan and Scholarship Program all as may be authorized by law, for the
28 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the biennial period ending
29 June 30, 1997, the following:

1 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
2 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
3 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
4 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
5 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
7 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
8 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
9 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
10 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
11 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
