18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - UTILITIES DIVISION. There is hereby
21 established for the Arkansas Public Service Commission - Utilities Division
22 for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
23 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
25 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

29 SECTION 16. CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. In the event of unforeseen
 30 conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not authorized
 31 or contemplated in Section 3 of this Act and such events make it necessary
 32 that the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division receives additional
 33 appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the Director of the
 34 Public Service Commission is hereby authorized to request the approval of the
 35 ~~Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter provided,~~

1 for transfer of the additional appropriations provided in Section 13 to the
 2 appropriations provided the Utilities Division by Section 3, but in no event
 3 shall the transfers exceed the appropriations provided in Section 13 of this
 4 Act. Whenever the Director of the Public Service Commission deems it
 5 necessary to establish additional appropriations as authorized herein, he
 6 shall file with the Governor a written report accompanied by necessary
 7 supporting documents setting forth the facts, justifications, and
 8 circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon receipt of such
 9 reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his designee, shall study
 10 the same, and if he shall determine that such additional appropriations are
 11 being sought in strict compliance with this Act, the Governor, after seeking
 12 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget
 13 Committee, may approve or modify such request for additional appropriations as
 14 in his judgement he deems necessary, and shall forward a copy thereof to the
 15 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon receipt thereof, the Chief Fiscal
 16 Officer of the State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer
 17 upon his books in accordance with the provisions as set out therein.

27 (b) A monthly report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council
 28 describing all personnel transactions involving applications of any of the
 29 provisions of this Section.

30 (c) This provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium
 31 beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1997.

32

33 SECTION 18. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation
 34 authorized in Item (08) of Section 3 of this Act which remains at the close of
 35 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be carried forward and made

1 available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.

2

3 SECTION 19. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for
4 Renovation & Repairs to Building in Item (09) of Section 3 of this Act which
5 remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be carried
6 forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending
7 June 30, 1997.

8

9 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
15 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
16 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27

28 SECTION 22. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
29 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
30 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 23. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

2

3 SECTION 24. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

5

6 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
7 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
8 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
9 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
