13 "TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF EXPLOSIVE
14 OR INCENDIARY DEVICE."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-71-301 is hereby amended to read
19 as follows:

20 "5-71-301. Definitions.

21 As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

22 (1) Civil disorder means any public disturbance involving acts of
23 violence by assemblages of three (3) or more persons, which causes an
24 immediate danger of or results in damage or injury to the property or person
25 of any other individual;

26 (2) Explosive or incendiary device includes:

27 (A) Dynamite and all other forms of high explosives;

28 (B) Any explosive bomb, grenade, missile, or similar device;

29 (C) Explosive materials meaning explosives, blasting agents and
30 detonators; and

31 (D) Any incendiary bomb or grenade, fire bomb, or similar device;
32 and including any device which consists of or includes a breakable container
33 containing a flammable liquid or compound and a wick composed of any material
34 which, when ignited, is capable of igniting such flammable liquid or compound,
35 and can be carried or thrown by one (1) individual acting alone;

36 (3) Firearm means a firearm as defined by § 5-1-102.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
