REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the 19 20 Arkansas Constitutional Convention for the 21st Century the following maximum 21 number of regular employees as set out in this section and whose salaries 22 shall not exceed the maximum amounts hereinafter set forth. No greater salary 23 than that established herein shall be paid to any employee of the Convention 24 from appropriated funds herein, provided that in determining the salaries of 25 such employees, consideration shall be given to ability and capacity of the 26 employee to perform the job for which employed. 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4	SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict	
5	with this Act are hereby repealed.	
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7	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the	
8	Eightieth General Assembly meeting in First Extraordinary Session, that	
9	legislation has been proposed to call a Constitutional Convention with the	
10	authority and responsibility to revise the Constitution of the State of	
11	Arkansas; that financial provisions must be made to cover the expenses of the	
12	Arkansas Constitutional Convention for the 21st Century; and that the	
13	effectiveness of this Act upon its passage and approval is essential to the	
14	operation of the Arkansas Constitutional Convention for the 21st Century for	
15	which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that a delay in the	
16	effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper	
17	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an	
18	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the	
19	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full	
20	force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
