9 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO SUBMIT A REPORT  
10 REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE LOWER  
11 MISSISSIPPI DELTA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO SUBMIT A  
16 REPORT REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF  
17 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE LOWER MISSISSIPPI  
18 DELTA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION"

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. All relevant state agencies shall submit to the Governor and  
23 the Legislative Council a report detailing the progress of the agency in  
24 implementing the recommendations of the Lower Mississippi Delta Development  
25 Commissions Final Report of 1990. Also, such agencies shall report on other  
26 initiatives developed and implemented by the agency for the Eastern Arkansas  
27 Delta Region since 1990.  
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
