9 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
10 ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN  
11 COUNTRIES FOR THE RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF DRIVERS  
12 LICENSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
16 AND ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO  
17 AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES FOR  
18 THE RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF DRIVERS  
19 LICENSES."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Title 27, Chapter 16, Subchapter 8 of the Arkansas Code is  
24 amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

25 "27-16-809. The Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration is  
26 authorized to enter into driver license agreements or other cooperative  
27 arrangements with foreign countries for the reciprocal recognition of drivers  
28 licenses."  
29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
