9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-16-105 TO EXEMPT  
10 CONSERVATION EASEMENTS GRANTED BY COUNTIES FROM THE  
11 PROCEDURES FOR SALE OF COUNTY PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO EXEMPT CONSERVATION EASEMENTS  
16 GRANTED BY COUNTIES FROM THE PROCEDURES  
17 FOR SALE OF COUNTY PROPERTY."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-16-105(b) is amended by adding at the end  
22 thereof a new subdivision to read as follow:

23 "(4) An order and the procedures described in this section shall not be  
24 required for any conveyance by the county of a conservation easement as  
25 described in § 15-20-401 et seq. However, no such conveyance shall be made  
26 unless authorized by a majority vote of the quorum court."  
27

28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 14-16-105(f)(2) is amended by adding at the  
29 end thereof a new subsection to read as follows:

30 "(C) Where the county is conveying a conservation easement as described  
31 in §15-20-401 et seq. for any of the purposes enumerated in § 15-20-401 et  
32 seq. as the same may be amended from time to time."  
33

34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
