9 "AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE ANY MOTOR VEHICLE
10 ON ANY PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY WITH ANY AUXILIARY DRIVING
11 LIGHTS EXCEPT FOR ORIGINAL LIGHTING EQUIPMENT OR FOG LAMPS
12 OR DRIVING OR PASSING LAMPS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF AUXILIARY
15 DRIVING LIGHTS ON MOTOR VEHICLES WHILE
16 ON A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY EXCEPT FOR
17 ORIGINAL LIGHTING EQUIPMENT OR FOG LAMPS
18 OR DRIVING OR PASSING LAMPS."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. It is unlawful to operate any motor vehicle on a public
24 street or highway with any auxiliary driving lights on unless such lights are
25 original equipment lighting installed by the vehicle manufacturer prior to the
26 initial retail sale of the motor vehicle, or fog lamps conforming to the
27 provisions set forth in Arkansas Code Ann. § 27-36-214(b), or are auxiliary
28 driving or passing lamps conforming to the provisions set forth in Arkansas
29 Code Ann. § 27-36-214(c) and (d).
30

31 SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 shall be
32 guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be punished accordingly.
33

34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
