## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-18-201(b) TO  
10 REDUCE THE NUMBER OF ADULT EDUCATION CLASS HOURS THAT  
11 STUDENTS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN ADULT EDUCATION AND EMPLOYED  
12 FOR THIRTY (30) OR MORE HOURS PER WEEK ARE REQUIRED TO  
13 ATTEND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF ADULT EDUCATION  
16 CLASS HOURS THAT STUDENTS WHO ARE  
17 ENROLLED IN ADULT EDUCATION AND EMPLOYED  
18 FOR 30 OR MORE HOURS PER WEEK ARE  
19 REQUIRED TO ATTEND."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23  
24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-18-201(b)(7) and (8) are amended  
25 to read as follows:

26 "(b)(7) The adult education program shall require, for continued  
27 enrollment, a minimum of twenty (20) hours per week of class attendance and  
28 instruction; provided, however, that a minimum of ten (10) hours shall be  
29 required for any student who is employed for thirty (30) hours or more each  
30 week;

31 (8) The student, the student's parents, guardians, or persons in  
32 loco parentis, and the administrative head of the adult education program  
33 agree in writing that the student will attend ~~a minimum of twenty (20) the~~  
34 requisite number of hours per week and maintain appropriate conduct as  
35 outlined in the local adult education program student handbook;"

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
12 hereby repealed.
