9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-17-1113 TO
10 PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION INSURE SCHOOL
11 DISTRICTS AGAINST CIVIL LIABILITY THROUGH SELF INSURANCE
12 OR A GROUP INSURANCE POLICY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF
16 EDUCATION INSURE SCHOOL DISTRICTS
17 AGAINST CIVIL LIABILITY THROUGH SELF
18 INSURANCE OR A GROUP INSURANCE POLICY"

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 6-17-1113 is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "6-17-1113. Civil liability insurance.

25 (a) The Department of Education is authorized and directed to establish
26 a self-insurance fund or to negotiate for and procure a group or blanket
27 policy or policies of insurance, or both, insuring education service
28 cooperatives, education service cooperative board members, school districts,
29 school board members, school treasurers/bookkeepers school nurses, school
30 secretaries, substitute teachers, authorized volunteers, school custodians,
31 food service workers employed by public schools, bus drivers and mechanics
32 employed by public schools, maintenance personnel employed by public schools,
33 each employee of a public school district and each employee of the Arkansas
34 School for the Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind who is required to
35 hold a teaching certificate issued by the Department of Education, each
36 teacher's aide and each student teacher in a public school district or in the

1 Arkansas School for the Deaf or the Arkansas School for the Blind, and each
2 member of the dormitory staff of the Arkansas School for the Deaf or the
3 Arkansas School for the Blind against civil liability for acts or omissions of
4 each employee in the performance of his or her official duties as a school
5 employee, including civil liability for administering corporal punishment to
6 students, in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for
7 each incident.

8 (b) The premium on such policy or policies shall be paid annually out
9 of funds in the Public School Fund that are set aside for distribution to the
10 various school districts under Acts 1977, No. 384 [repealed].

11 (c) The Department of Education shall adopt appropriate rules and
12 regulations necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

13 (d) Any school districts previously covered by the self-insurance
14 program of the Department of Education shall be deemed a proper expenditure of
15 state funds."

16

17 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
18 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
19 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

20

21 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
23 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
24 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
25 act are declared to be severable.

26

27 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
28 hereby repealed.
