## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-35-210 TO AUTHORIZE THE  
11 STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS TO  
12 TRANSPORT ROUND BALES OF HAY ON CONTROLLED HIGHWAYS  
13 PROVIDED THAT THE LOAD DOES NOT EXCEED TEN FEET IN WIDTH;  
14 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

17 "TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE HIGHWAY  
18 COMMISSION TO ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS TO  
19 TRANSPORT ROUND BALES OF HAY ON  
20 CONTROLLED HIGHWAYS PROVIDED THAT THE  
21 LOAD DOES NOT EXCEED TEN FEET IN WIDTH."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-210 is amended by inserting an  
26 additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:

27 "(j) The State Highway Commission may issue special permits authorizing  
28 the transport of round bales of hay on controlled highways under its  
29 jurisdiction provided that the load does not exceed ten (10) feet in width.  
30 The special permits shall be issued without fee or other charge and shall  
31 expire *three* (3) days after the date of issuance."

32

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 act are declared to be severable.

6

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
8 hereby repealed.
