ACT 229 OF 1997
HOUSE BILL 1134

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND ADULT
EDUCATION PROGRAMS SHALL DISTRIBUTE SELECTIVE SERVICE
REGISTRATION FORMS TO THOSE STUDENTS REQUIRED TO REGISTER
WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO PROVIDE THAT LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS
AND ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS SHALL
DISTRIBUTE SELECTIVE SERVICE
REGISTRATION FORMS TO THOSE STUDENTS
REQUIRED TO REGISTER WITH THE SELECTIVE
SERVICE SYSTEM."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a)(1) Each local school district and each adult education
program shall provide a registration form, at least thirty (30) days before
the student's eighteenth birthday, to any student who is enrolled in the
district or the adult education program and is required to register with the
selective service system in accordance with the Military Selective Service
Act, 50 U.S.C. Appx. § 451 et seq.

(2) The district and adult education program shall further
provide appropriate instructions for returning completed registration forms to
selective service personnel.

(b) The superintendent of the local school district and the director of
the adult education program shall designate a staff person in each high school
and at the adult education program site to distribute selective service
registration forms to students as provided in subsection (a) of this section.

1 (c) The Department of Education shall issue rules and regulations to
2 ensure compliance with the provisions of this act.

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4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
