10 "AN ACT TO CONSOLIDATE THE STATE FORESTRY COMMISSIONS
11 TRUST FUNDS PURSUANT TO ARKANSAS CODE §19-4-509; TO CLARIFY
12 THE PURPOSES AND PROCEEDS OF THE TRUST FUND; TO CLASSIFY
13 CERTAIN STATE FORESTRY COMMISSION REVENUES AS SPECIAL
14 REVENUES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 "AN ACT TO CONSOLIDATE THE FORESTRY
19 COMMISSIONS TRUST FUNDS."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. The Arkansas General Assembly established two trust funds to
24 be used by the State Forestry Commission. The Board of the State Forestry
25 Commission now has determined that a single, consolidated trust fund would
26 provide for efficient financial administration. The policy of the State of
27 Arkansas as set out at Arkansas Code §19-4-509 is that only the minimum number
28 of funds should be established since unnecessary funds result in
29 inflexibility, undue complexity, and inefficient financial administration.
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31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code §19-5-927 is amended to read as follows:
32 "19-5-927. State Forest Trust Fund.

33 (a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State,
34 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be
35 known as the State Forestry Trust Fund.

36 (b) This fund shall consist of:

1 (1) The balances on the effective date of this act of the State
2 Forest Trust Fund and the Emergency Fire Trust Fund, which are hereby
3 abolished;

4 (2) Income derived from management of state forests by the State
5 Forestry Commission to the extent this income is not needed to fund the
6 general operations of the State Forestry Commission; and

7 (3) Income derived from management of state nurseries by the
8 State Forestry Commission to the extent this income is not needed to fund the
9 general operations of the State Forestry Commission.

10 (c) ~~It~~ This fund shall be used for:

11 (1) The management and improvement of state forests;

12 (2) ~~Payments to the Federal Government for a~~ Acquisition of
13 state forests;

14 (3) ~~The transfer of funds, as determined by the State Forestry~~
15 ~~Commission, to the Emergency Fire Trust Fund for the purchase of fire fighting~~
16 equipment and other forest fire suppression activities; and

17 (4) Improvements at State Forestry Commission nurseries and the
18 seedling storage and distribution system; and

19 ~~(4)~~ (5) Such other purposes as may be authorized by law. ~~2~~

21 SECTION 3. Income derived from management of state forests by the State
22 Forestry Commission and income derived from management of state nurseries by
23 the State Forestry Commission shall be classified as Special Revenues under
24 the Revenue Classification Law.

26 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §19-5-928 is hereby repealed.

27 ~~19 5 928. Emergency Fire Trust Fund.~~

28 ~~(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State,~~
29 ~~Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be~~
30 ~~known as the Emergency Fire Trust Fund.~~

31 ~~(b) This fund shall consist of the unexpended and unobligated cash~~
32 ~~funds of the State Forestry Commission deposited in the State Treasury to the~~
33 ~~credit of the fund, and any transfer of funds from the State Forest Trust~~
34 ~~fund.~~

35 ~~(c) It shall be used for combating forest fires, on an emergency basis,~~
36 ~~and for the purchase of fire fighting equipment whenever other moneys are not~~

1 ~~available to the commission.~~

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3 SECTION 5. For the biennium ending June 30, 1999, the sum of the
4 appropriations for the Emergency Fire Trust Fund and the State Forest Trust
5 Fund shall apply to the State Forestry Trust Fund.

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7 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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11 SECTION 7. If any provision of this or the application thereof to any
12 person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other
13 provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the
14 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act
15 are declared to be severable.

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17 SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
18 hereby repealed.

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20 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

21 It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly
22 that the consolidation of the Forestry Commission's Trust Funds is essential
23 to be in force at the beginning of the state fiscal year and that the
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of the
25 agency for which the trust funds in this Act are provided, and that in the
26 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
27 of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
28 administration and provision of essential governmental programs and would
29 impede the Forestry Commission from complying with the policy of the State of
30 Arkansas as set out in Arkansas Code § 19-4-509. Therefore, an emergency is
31 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
32 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
33 effect from and after July 1, 1997.
