13 "THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROFESSIONAL  
14 LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ACT."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
17

18 SECTION 1. (a) A limited liability company formed under Arkansas Code  
19 Annotated § 4-32-102 and that will engage in the practice of medicine must  
20 obtain a certificate of registration from the Arkansas State Medical Board and  
21 must comply with the statutes of the Medical Corporation Act as found in  
22 Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 4-29-301, et seq.

23 (b) A limited liability company formed under Arkansas Code Annotated §  
24 4-32-102 and that will engage in the practice of dentistry must obtain a  
25 certificate of registration and comply with the statutes in the Dental  
26 Corporation Act as found in Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 4-29-401, et seq.  
27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
36 act are declared to be severable.
