9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-14-1102 TO AUTHORIZE
10 COUNTY JUDGES TO APPROVE IN ADVANCE CLAIMS PAYABLE TO THE
11 UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE FOR
12 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO BE RENDERED DURING THE CURRENT
13 FISCAL YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-14-1102 TO

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-14-1102(b)(2)(B)(iv) is amended to read as
27 follows:

28 "(iv) The goods or services for which expenditure is to be made have
29 been rendered and the payment thereof has been incurred in a lawful manner and
30 is owed by the county. However, a county judge may approve, in advance,
31 claims payable to the University of Arkansas Cooperative Extension Service for
32 educational services to be rendered during all or part of the current fiscal
33 year."
34

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
