## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
10 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOR  
11 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE GATEWAY TECHNICAL  
16 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99  
17 BIENNIUM."  
18

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
22 Gateway Technical College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum  
23 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
24 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
25 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
26 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
27 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
28 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
29 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
30 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
31 successor.

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19 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Gateway  
 20 Technical College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of  
 21 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
 22 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty six (26) temporary or  
 23 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided  
 24 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this  
 25 act for the appropriate classification.

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27 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Gateway  
 28 Technical College, to be payable from the Gateway Technical College Fund, for  
 29 personal services and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical College for  
 30 the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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14 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 15 to the Gateway Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
 16 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Gateway Technical College, for personal services  
 17 ~~and operating expenses of the Gateway Technical College for the biennial~~  
 18 period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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35 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - PRIORITIES. A high priority of the

1 Gateway Technical College is to provide quality technical training programs,  
2 transfer programs, and industrial training in the workplace.

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4 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - The appropriation level provided in  
5 Section 3 of this Act shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas  
6 General Assembly to provide a particular level of support from the Work Force  
7 2000 Development Fund for the Gateway Technical College but rather that the  
8 funds to be made available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and  
9 accreditation requirements as determined by the State Board of Higher  
10 Education for all technical colleges.

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12 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
18 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
19 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
20 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
21 disbursement of said funds.

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23 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
25 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
26 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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1 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
4 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
5 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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7 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
8 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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10 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
11 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
12 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
13 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
15 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
16 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
17 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
