15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 Arkansas Tech University for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum
22 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
23 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
24 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
25 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
26 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
27 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
30 successor.

7 Tech University for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of
8 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
9 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: eight hundred eighty six (886)
10 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
11 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
12 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

14 SECTION 3. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS MINING, ENERGY AND NATURAL
15 RESOURCES RESEARCH INSTITUTE. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
16 Tech University - Arkansas Mining, Energy and Natural Resources Research
17 Institute for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time
18 or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
19 appropriated herein for such purposes: fourteen (14) temporary or part-time
20 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
21 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for
22 the appropriate classification.

24 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. EXTRA-HELP - SATELLITE NURSING PROGRAM.
25 There is hereby authorized for the Arkansas Tech University-Satellite Nursing
26 Program for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or
27 temporary employees to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
28 appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time
29 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the

4 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FOOD SERVICE. If Arkansas Tech
5 University cancels the current contract for food service and chooses to
6 operate the food service with University employees, the President, upon
7 authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to utilize the contingent
8 positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided he or she has obtained
9 approval from the Department of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer
10 of the State, who has sought prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

11

12 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions
18 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
19 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
20 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
21 disbursement of said funds.

22

23 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
25 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
26 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31

32 SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
33 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
34 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35

1 SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
4 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
5 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

6
7 SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
8 with this Act are hereby repealed.

9
10 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
11 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
12 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
13 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of
14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
16 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the
17 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
