9 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS HISTORIC PRESERVATION  
10 PROGRAM TO PROMULGATE A BUILDING CODE FOR HISTORIC  
11 BUILDINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS  
15 HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM TO  
16 PROMULGATE A BUILDING CODE FOR HISTORIC  
17 BUILDINGS."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) The Arkansas Historic Preservation Program may by  
22 regulation promulgated pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act adopt an  
23 Arkansas Historic Building Code for buildings listed individually on the  
24 National Register of Historic Places, buildings eligible for listing  
25 individually on the National Register of Historic Places, and buildings listed  
26 as a contributing resource in a National Register Historic District.

27 (b) To the extent the provisions of the Arkansas Historic Building Code  
28 adopted by the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program conflicts with any state  
29 or local building or fire code, the Arkansas Historic Building Code shall  
30 prevail as to the buildings described in subsection (a).  
31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
35

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
