20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
23 State Highway and Transportation Department for the biennial period ending
24 June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001, the following maximum number of regular employees and the
25 maximum annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that
26 established herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations
27 hereinafter made for said department, except the maximum salaries herein
28 authorized may be exceeded by the salaries for the twenty-seventh pay period
29 for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2000. The annual salaries to be paid
30 to each employee authorized herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway
31 Commission within the limitations as set out in this Section and the funds and
32 the appropriations made available for such purposes. All positions established
33 herein shall be exempt from the provisions of the Uniform Personnel
34 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
35 successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act . Provided further that the salaries for the

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1 pay periods beginning ~~June 19, 1997~~ July 1, 1999 and ~~June 18, 1998~~ June 22,
 2 2000 can be paid from the salaries and overtime authorized for the fiscal
 3 years ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000 and June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001 respectively.

10 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 11 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME. The
 12 Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its
 13 employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the
 14 policies established by the Commission. The executives and administrators of

14 Department employees for liability coverage on state owned vehicles of the

18 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

20 UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
21 Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2 hereof, the
22 Unemployment Premiums and Workers Compensation Premiums, at a rate not in
23 excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of regulations
24 established by the Department of Finance and Administration.

26 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING
28 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to take
29 appropriate action as necessary to restrict or reduce the operating,
30 administration, and other associated costs of the State Highway and
31 Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police Division, for
32 the biennial period ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001. Provided further, that the
33 Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas Legislative
34 Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial activities
35 of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least quarterly,
36 beginning no later than September 30, 1989.

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SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 17. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 18. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 19. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that

1 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
4 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
5 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
6 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
7 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
8 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
