20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
23 Employment Security Department for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following
24 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
25 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
26 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
28 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
32 successor.

28 FORWARD - NEW HIRE REGISTRY. Any balance in the appropriation and funds made
29 available by this Act for the New Hire Registry which remain on June 30, ~~1998~~
30 2000, may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for the
31 same purpose.

32
33 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
34 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP.
35 There is hereby authorized, for the Employment Security Department for the
36 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary

1 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein
2 for such purposes: four hundred (400) temporary or part-time employees, when
3 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
4 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate
5 classification. Any of these positions utilized in a manner which are funded
6 by federal sources are specifically exempt from limitation of hours, either by
7 Act or Regulation.

8
9 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
10 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
11 Any unexpended balance of appropriation made by this Act, with the exception
12 of appropriation made for Regular Salaries and Maintenance and General
13 Operation, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1998~~
14 2000, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001.

16
17 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED ACT
19 FUNDS". Funds made available to the State under Section 903 of the Social
20 Security Act may be used, under the direction of the Employment Security
21 Department with respect to federal fiscal year 1999, for the purpose of
22 construction, and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of
23 land and/or for the payment of salaries and related benefits of local office
24 staff. Monies credited with respect to federal fiscal years 2000 and 2001
25 shall be used solely for the administration of the unemployment compensation
26 program or as otherwise prescribed in Section 903 of the Social Security Act,
27 as amended.

28
29 The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by
30 which (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this
31 State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act exceeds (b) the
32 aggregate of the amounts used by this State and charged against the amounts
33 transferred to the account of this State.

34
35 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
36 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL

1 POSITIONS. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after
2 receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after
3 seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the
4 authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may
5 become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet
6 Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are
7 financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons may
8 be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and that
9 the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the salary schedule for
10 comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of this
11 Act.

12

13 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
15 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented
16 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought the prior
17 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Director of the Employment
18 Security Department is hereby authorized to make transfers from any
19 appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation made by this Act
20 with the exception of the "Reed Act Funds" appropriations set forth in Section
21 ~~10~~ 11 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or
22 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it
23 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this
24 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that
25 there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or items
26 which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be effected
27 only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, however,
28 that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the total
29 amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General
30 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

31

32 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
34 FORWARD. Any balance in the General Revenue funds made available by this Act
35 as matching funds for the Welfare-to-Work Initiative which remains on June 30,
36 2000, may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for the

1 same purpose.

2
3 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING
5 FUNDS ALLOCATION. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after
6 review and recommendation from the state Workforce Investment Board and in
7 coordination with the Arkansas Transitional Employment Board, will allocate
8 the State General Revenue matching funds and other available welfare-to-work
9 funds, in accordance with welfare-to-work priorities set by the state and in
10 accordance with federal requirements. The Director, will implement an in-
11 depth program evaluation process of welfare-to-work activities and report
12 results to the Workforce Investment Board and the Transitional Employment
13 Board.

14
15 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
17 TRANSFER TO THE ARKANSAS WORKFORCE INVESTMENT FUND. In the event other funds
18 are not available, of the funds made available to the Employment Security
19 Department from the Department of Human Services Fund from June 30, 1999
20 balances derived from savings in Welfare Reform Initiatives by the Department
21 of Human Services during the 1998-99 fiscal year for a transfer by warrant for
22 matching funds for Welfare-to-Work Grants for Transitional Employment
23 Assistance recipients six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) of these monies
24 shall be transferred to Arkansas Workforce Investment Fund.

25
26 SECTION 26. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
29 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
30 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
31 and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
32 their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
33 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
34 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
35 disbursement of said funds.

36

1 SECTION 27. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 8 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9
 10 SECTION 28. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13
 14 SECTION 29. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
 15 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 16 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 17 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 18 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

19
 20 SECTION 30. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 21 this act are hereby repealed.

22
 23 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 24 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
 25 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
 26 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
