## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE LICENSING OF NEWLY PURCHASED  
10 MOTOR VEHICLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

### Subtitle

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-14-902(a) is amended to read as follows:

21 "(a)(1) Whenever the owner of a registered vehicle transfers or assigns  
22 his title, or interest thereto, the registration of the vehicle shall expire.

23 (2) The owner shall remove the license plate or plates ~~and any~~  
24 ~~plate sticker, metal tab, or decal~~ therefrom and forward them to the office,  
25 ~~or he may have such plate or plates and plate sticker, metal tab, or decal,~~  
26 ~~and the registration number thereon,~~ assigned to another vehicle, upon payment  
27 of the fees required by law and subject to the rules and regulations of the  
28 office.

29 (3) Whenever the owner elects to assign such plate or plates to a  
30 replacement vehicle, the owner may display the plate or plates on the  
31 replacement vehicle prior to registering such vehicle within the time  
32 permitted by § 27-14-903, provided the owner has complied with § 27-14-  
33 701(c). "

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
10 hereby repealed.
